

Plates

The hot glass is "ironed" flat with a pear-wood frame and then formed into the desired shape. Roberto Niederer developed this technique in the 60s.

All dishes in the Glasi factory restaurant are served on these plates.

Production method:

Hand-pressed and lowered into the mould.
